29 Singapore Youth Flying Club Trainees Attained Private Pilot Licence

The Singapore Youth Flying Club (SYFC) held its Private Pilot Licence (PPL) Wings & Aviation Awards Ceremony on 17 May 2025. 29 Junior College and Polytechnic students received the coveted SYFC Wings after graduating from the SYFC PPL course and attaining their PPL issued by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS). Gracing the ceremony was the Chief of Air Force and Chairman of the SYFC Board of Governors, Major-General (MG) Kelvin Fan.
- 2. In his speech, MG Fan congratulated the young graduates for their achievement, noting that it was not easy completing the challenging PPL course alongside other school and family commitments. MG Fan also encouraged the graduates to pursue the higher calling of serving the nation in the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF).
- 3. During the ceremony, MG Fan presented the ST Engineering Excellence Award to the top three performing graduates in the flying and ground school categories. He also presented the SYFC CCA Excellence Award to Bedok Green Secondary School, Changkat Changi Secondary School, and Hwa Chong Institution, in recognition of their contributions to the SYFC aeromodelling CCA programme offered to Secondary School students. Currently, 18 Secondary Schools in Singapore conduct the aeromodelling CCA in the schools, in collaboration with SYFC.
